C. Consider and Approve Agreement with Spade Wind II, for an Appraised Value Limitation on Qualified Property for School District Maintenance and Operations Taxes

The Board on a motion by Sims Price and second by Mike Knittel voted 6-0 to approve the application as submitted and determined to be complete by the Comptroller; and approve the agreement as timely submitted to the Comptroller's Office for review; and grans an extension of the 150 days to approve or disapprove an application and for the final execution of this agreement until 30 days after the Comptroller's Office provides the economic impact evaluation required by Texas Tax Code 313.025(b) and any other requirements of the Texas Tax Code; and direct the Superintendent to notify the Comptroller of the extension of time and to demand completion of the economic impact study; and to authorize the Board President and Secretary to execute the agreement upon Comptroller's completion of the required statutory tasks.
