Meal Charge Policy

1. Meals may not be charged in grades 9-12. Charging is allowed in grades k-8, with a maximum of \$10. When the \$10 limit is reached, students will be served a cheese sandwich and white milk for lunch and toast and white milk for breakfast.
2. Prepayment of meals is highly recommended. Parents may pay online by accessing the Sterling City ISD homepage or www.myschoolbucks.com. Cash or check payments may be made at the cafeteria. It is preferable that payments not be made during serving time.
3. Free and Reduced Meal applications are available from school cafeteria, each office, and on the Sterling City ISD website under Food Services. These applications are available year round and assistance is available in completing the application.
4. Students with carryover balances from previous year, but presently qualified for Free/Reduced Meals, shall not be allowed to buy a la carte unless past due charges are paid off. They will be served the standard reimbursable meal.
5. Letters of negative balances are sent out weekly. Phone calls, text messages, and email of negative balances are made daily.
6. Past due charges will be reported to each Principal.
