Item	Acceptable Dress	Special Comments and interpretations
Shirts, Blouses	Shirts/Blouses may be: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Sleeves are required on boy garments 	Students are prohibited from wearing shirts/blouses that: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Sleeveless shirts for girls must be 3 in width with no undergarments showing Advertise alcohol, drugs, tobacco, the occult, gangs, inappropriate words, or lewd pictures Are see through apparel or clothing with holes Have Tube-Tops, halter tops, spaghetti straps, half shirts, tank tops, muscle shirts, crop tops, low cut, or any shirt, which allows the navel or bra to show. Any shirt/blouse that does not come to the waistband or exposes the midriff while standing, walking, or sitting must be worn with an undershirt that tucks in. Students back may not show sitting or standing. Are excessively tight
Pants, Slacks	Acceptable pants/slacks must be appropriately sized and worn at the waist. Pants that have holes at or below the knee are acceptable. Holes above the knee will require a patch or covering so skin does not show.	The following are not acceptable: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Be excessively long, large, or sag below the top of the hip line or allow undergarments to show. Have holes or tears. Above the knee. Be oversized, baggy, or excessively tight- for example yoga pants.
Shorts	Length of shorts must be a hands width or four fingers together from the top of the knee.	The following are not acceptable: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Short shorts Shorts with holes or tears Excessively tight shorts
Dresses, skorts, skirts	Length of shorts must be a hands width or four fingers together from the top of the knee.	The following are not acceptable: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Short dresses, skorts, and skirts Clothing with holes or tears Dresses that are low cut in front/back or sleeveless Excessively tight dresses, skorts, skirts
Shoes	Shoes shall be worn at all times. Shoes should be appropriate for identified curricular and co-curricular activities.	The following are not acceptable: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> House shoes Slippers Shoes with wheels
Hair, Facial Hair	Hair shall be a natural color, clean, well groomed Male students must be clean-shaven. Sideburns must not extend below the ear lobe. Male hair must be neatly trimmed and worn in a style above the eye brow that exposes the earlobe and has a length above the collar of a button-up shirt or crew neck t-shirt.	Hair shall not be: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Distracting to the learning environment No Spikes or sculptured hair styles No patterns or designs shaved or cut into the hair No Mohawks or Faux Hawks Neon, Bleached or shaded a non natural color No Feathers or any colored extensions Hair coloring or bleaching for the purpose of creating extreme differences in color, shade, or tone between the student's natural and original hair color and the colored or bleached color, shade, or tone.
Jewelry	Earrings, hair jewelry, watches, bracelets, rings, and necklaces that are not a safety hazard or a material or substantial disruption may be worn	The following are not acceptable: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Jewelry that may be identified as gang related Earrings for boys is prohibited Chains, pocket chains, or chains attached to wallets, footwear, pants, or backpacks Body piercings, other than earrings, including, but not limited to nose rings, and studs, eyebrow loops and studs, lip rings and studs, tongue piercings, and the like. Shaped wrist bands, or wrist bands with inappropriate writing.
General	School-approved uniforms for physical education, pep rallies, etc. may be worn only during the class or activity for which they are approved. For unique special events the campus administration may establish event-specific dress code requirements	The following are not acceptable: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Any clothing that promotes violence or violation of school rules, or are lewd, offensive, vulgar, contain obscene language, sexually explicit language or images, or that materially or substantially disrupts the learning environment Extremely tight fitting clothing, such as spandex, or bicycle shorts Leggings as the primary garment, must have dress or skirt at appropriate length (same criteria as shorts listed above) Hoods as a head covering inside the building Pajamas or loungewear Sunglasses, combs picks, brushes, or headgear, including but not limited to hats, caps, sweatbands, bandanas, or do-rags visible worn during the school day. Costume contact lens Carrying blankets around will not be permitted.
